SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT

1. Judgment shall enter in favor of the Plaintiff, Attorney General Peter F. Kilmartin, and against the Defendant, Rhode Island Department of Business Regulation, on Plaintiff's Complaint.
2. The Rhode Island Department of Business Regulation acknowledges that it is a public body and is subject to the Access to Public Records Act ("APRA"). See R.I. Gen. Laws § 38-2-1 et. seq.
3. The Rhode Island Department of Business Regulation acknowledges that it failed to timely provide a response to an APRA request dated July 10, 2013, as required by Rhode Island General Laws § 38-2-7(a). Accordingly, the Rhode Island Department of Business Regulation acknowledges that it violated the APRA.
4. The Rhode Island Department of Business Regulation further agrees to pay to the State of Rhode Island a one thousand dollar (\$1,000.00) civil fine, such fine to be paid within thirty (30) days of signing this Settlement Agreement, and no other costs or fees shall be assessed.
5. This Settlement Agreement shall become effective on the date of its entry and is binding upon the Rhode Island Department of Business Regulation, its agents, servants, successors, assigns, and all persons, corporations or entities acting through or for it.
6. In consideration of the payment by the Rhode Island Department of Business Regulation of a one thousand dollar (\$1,000.00) civil fine, this case is dismissed.


