

SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT

1. Judgment shall enter in favor of the Plaintiff, Attorney General Peter F. Kilmartin, and against the Defendant, Nasonville Fire Department/District, on Plaintiff's Complaint.
2. The Defendant, Nasonville Fire Department/District acknowledges that it is a public body and is subject to the Access to Public Records Act ("APRA"). See R.I. Gen. Laws § 38-2-1 et. seq.
3. The Defendant, Nasonville Fire Department/District acknowledges that it failed to timely provide a response to an APRA request filed by the International Association of Fire Fighters dated January 15, 2014, as required by Rhode Island General Laws § 38-2-7(a). Accordingly, the Defendant, Nasonville Fire Department/District acknowledges that it violated the APRA.
4. The Defendant, Nasonville Fire Department/District further agrees to pay to the State of Rhode Island a one thousand five hundred dollar (\$1,500.00) civil fine, such fine to be paid within thirty (30) days of signing this Settlement Agreement, and no other costs or fees shall be assessed.
5. This Settlement Agreement shall become effective on the date of its entry and is binding upon the Defendant, Nasonville Fire Department/District, its agents, servants, successors, assigns, and all persons, corporations or entities acting through or for it.
6. In consideration of the payment by the Defendant, Nasonville Fire Department/District of the one thousand five hundred dollar (\$1,500.00) civil fine, this case is dismissed.


