## Case Report (LFerreras)

On Sunday, October 18, 2020 at approximately 1600 hours Officers assigned to the Broad Street detail along with units from Districts 1, 2, 3, 8 and 9 were dispatched to the areas of India Point Park to disperse a large number of approximately three hundred motorcycles, dirt bikes and ATVs. Police were advised that the large group were operating on sidewalks and disobeying properly functioning traffic signals. As police arrived in the area of India Street, police observed the large group operating recklessly. The operators of the mentioned motor vehicles were observed overtaking vehicles, traveling in the opposite lane of travel, operating on sidewalks, using profanities towards police and blocking off roads preventing other motor vehicles from continuing their right of travel.

Although there were many close encounters of possible traffic accidents, Police managed to disperse the large group from this area. The large group was observed dispersing in many different directions towards the city. Moments later the Dispatcher advised the surrounding districts that numerous calls of illegal motorcycles, dirt bikes and ATVs were traveling recklessly throughout the city. While monitoring numerous broadcasts, Police were advised that a large number of the group were making their way towards District 3 traveling outbound on Elmwood Avenue. While operating outbound on Elmwood Avenue the large group (approximately two to three hundred) were again observed traveling at high speeds, traveling on sidewalks, operating left of center, acting out stunts (wheelies), and obstructing normal flow of traffic.

As police continued to follow behind the large group traveling outbound on Elmwood Avenue a collision occurred at the corners of Elmwood Avenue and Bissell St. Police observed a male operator and black Moped on the ground. Police quickly gave aid to the male subject and summoned a rescue to respond to the scene. Providence Rescue responded to the scene and transported the male subject to Rhode Island Hospital.

Car 200 Lieutenant Currier, K9-1 Sergeant Desautels, Car 225 Sergeant Dyer, Traffic Bureau Reconstruction Team and BCI all arrived on scene.
